BARBRI Guarantee

If you take a BARBRI bar review course for the first time for a particular state and are unsuccessful on that state's bar exam, you may repeat the same course for the same state the next time a course is offered without paying tuition. Proof that you sat for and did not pass that state's bar exam is required. If you take a BARBRI bar review course for the first time for a particular state and do not sit for that state's bar exam, you may repeat the same course for the same state by paying ½ of the alumni tuition in effect at the time of taking the repeat course. Your repeat course is only available for the next exam offered and does not include any upgrades, including supplemental workshops or a second set of books. All guarantee students are entitled to new lecture handouts with their repeat course. If a new edition of books has been released, you must pay a \$250 refundable book deposit to enroll in the repeat course. If the edition of books is the same as those used in your original course, you must pay a \$250 refundable book deposit if you wish to receive new books. Alumni tuition will apply on all subsequent courses for up to 10 years.
