

CHIEF JUSTICE ANNOUNCES DOCUMENT ACCESS FOR BAR MEMBERS

Oregon Supreme Court Chief Justice Thomas A. Balmer today announced that Oregon State Bar members now can access court documents online.

“Law Day is a perfect time to be able to provide this service to Oregon lawyers and their clients,” Balmer said. “The two biggest benefits that Bar members wanted from Oregon eCourt were the ability to electronically file and serve documents and to have online access to court documents. We now provide that in 10 circuit courts, and it will be coming soon in Multnomah County. This meets the goals of both the Oregon eCourt Program and the Oregon Judicial Department by providing easier access to court information and to the courts, to help people resolve their disputes under the rule of law.”

More than 700 Bar members already have subscribed to document access in the 10 circuit courts now using the Oregon eCourt Case Information system.
