| OSB Law Improvement Bills | |
| Board of Governors | |
| SB 490 | This bill includes several issues, including changes necessitated by the implementation of AMS software, clarification of the role of the past-president, elimination of the obsolete vice-president position, and the renaming of the Executive Director position. |
| SB 491 | This bill includes changes proposed by the OSB Discipline Review Committee. These include: Creation of professional adjudicator; elimination of LRPCs; SPRB member appointed by Supreme Court; statutory immunity for mentors; and probation and diversion monitors. |
| Business Law Section | |
| HB 2610 | This bill was proposed by the Business Law Section and incorporates concepts from the Uniform Electronic Transmissions Act and the Electronic Signatures in Global and National Commerce Act |
| Estate Planning & Administration Section | |
| HB 2608 | Proposed by the Estate Planning Section, this bill corrects the effective date of HB 2331 (2015). |
| Family Law Section | |
| SB 492 | Proposed by the Family Law Section, this bill is a redraft of HB 2332 (2015), and is intended to streamline the process for parties to determine if a modification of spousal support is appropriate. |
| SB 522A | Proposed by the Family Law Section, this bill will provide courts with the ability to claim against a third party that is named as the beneficiary of life insurance that was ordered for the benefit of a child or former spouse. |
| Nonprofit Law Section | |
| HB 2609 | Proposed by the Nonprofit Organizations Law Section, this bill updates and modernizes ORS Chapter 65, the nonprofit code. Did not pass. Will be a part of interim work group discussions |
