

## Introductory Course in Access to Justice

Pursuant to MCLE Rule 3.3(b), all members reporting CLE credits for the first time must complete a three-credit hour introductory course in access to justice\*. The introductory courses in access to justice that are currently available are listed below.

In future reporting periods, any access to justice CLE programs may be used. It's only in the first reporting period that you specifically need an introductory course.

\*NOTE: If you are using a Comity Certificate of MCLE Compliance from Washington, Idaho or Utah to comply with your Oregon MCLE requirement, you are not required to complete the introductory course in access to justice.
