

What is a Law Student Associate?

The Law Student Associate status was created by the Oregon State Bar (OSB) and Oregon New Lawyers Division (ONLD) to offer you a way to join your future community of peers while still in law school.

Although it's not a membership in the OSB per se, your associate status brings with it the lion's share of OSB member benefits, and the right to participate actively in the ONLD.

You are very important to us: you represent the future of our profession, and we want to welcome you, hear your views, and work together with you. We have done our best to make it affordable for you to become an associate. Your \$10 annual dues cover only a small part of the cost of your benefits (your subscription to the Oregon State Bar Bulletin alone would normally be \$50 per year); the OSB and ONLD subsidize the remaining costs.

What do you get with your associateship?

Lawyers throughout Oregon recognize the Oregon State Bar as their main professional organization. Law Student Associates will build professional contacts through bar activities while demonstrating dedication and interest in the profession. This display of dedication to the state bar organization is especially helpful for out-of-state law students, whether planning to stay in the state or not.

You will also receive:

Home delivery of OSB/ONLD publications. Receive the *OSB Bulletin* and ONLD materials delivered to your home. These publications are invaluable to any student trying to figure out what is really going on in the legal profession.

Notice of upcoming CLE's. If you join a section as a Law Student Associate, you will receive notice of upcoming CLE's in areas of law related to your section. Many of these CLEs are free, or at nominal cost to associates, and provide an excellent, informal setting for learning and networking with lawyers in your fields of interest.

OSB Section membership. On the reverse side is a chart of all the OSB Sections that allow membership to Law Student Associates.

You do not need to become a Law Student Associate to join these sections, and you do not need to join sections to take advantage of the other benefits of becoming a Law Student Associate.
