Hon. Martha L. Walters

Oregon Supreme Court Justice. Justice Walters attended the University of Michigan and received a BA with distinction in 1972. She received her JD in 1977 from the University of Oregon Law School. After graduation, she was an employment attorney for nearly 30 years with the firms Harrang, Swanson, Long & Watkinson (1977-1985);

Swanson & Walters, PC (1985-1992); Walters Romm & Chanti, PC (1992-1995); Walters Romm Chanti & Dickens, PC (1995-2004); and Walters Chanti & Zennache, PC (2004-2006). In 2006, Governor Kulongoski appointed Justice Walters to the Oregon Supreme Court. Justice Walters is a past and present member of several esteemed legal organizations, including the Judicial Conference of the Ninth Circuit (1992-1995), National Employment Lawyers Association, Oregon Women Lawyers, Federal Bar Association, and American Law Institute; from 1993-1996 she served on the Oregon Trial Lawyers Association Board of Governors. In 2007, Justice Walters was elected as the President of the Uniform Law Commission (2007-2009), becoming that organization's first female president. She is a co-author of the Louis D. Brandeis School of Law at University of Louisville, Brandeis Law Journal article – "When the Only Way to Equal is to Acknowledge Difference: PGA Tour, Inc. v. Martin.'

Judge Eric J. Bergstrom

Multnomah County Circuit Court judge. Judge Bergstrom graduated from the University of Oregon in 1984 with a BS in Political Science. After graduation, he moved to Washington D.C. to intern with the U.S. Senate Commerce Committee. He then worked in government relations for Matson Navigation, a U.S. based steamship company. Judge

Bergstrom returned to Portland in 1987 and attended Lewis & Clark Law School with a Dean's Scholarship; he obtained his JD in 1990. He spent the next 15 years with the Multnomah County District Attorney's Office; in 2000 he became Senior Deputy in charge of the Gang and Robbery units. Governor Kulongoski appointed Judge Bergstrom to the Multnomah County Circuit Court bench in 2005.

Judge Michael McShane



Multnomah County Circuit Court judge. He has a BA in English Literature from Gonzaga University and earned his JD from Lewis & Clark Law School in 1988 after having moved to Portland to work with homeless parolees and probationers as a member of the Jesuit Volunteer Corps. After law school he rose through the ranks as a

Metropolitan Public Defender and in 1997 became a Multnomah County Circuit Court Judge Pro Tem. Governor Kitzhaber appointed Judge McShane to the Multnomah County bench in 2001 and he is one of four judges assigned to hear death penalty cases.

Judge McShane is active in the Portland community. He sits on the board of St. Andrew Nativity School, an inner city middle school for disadvantaged youth and he is also a member of the adjunct faculty at Lewis & Clark Law School. Judge McShane also opens his courtroom to the Classroom Law Project and he teaches a courtroom course for a local alternative school
