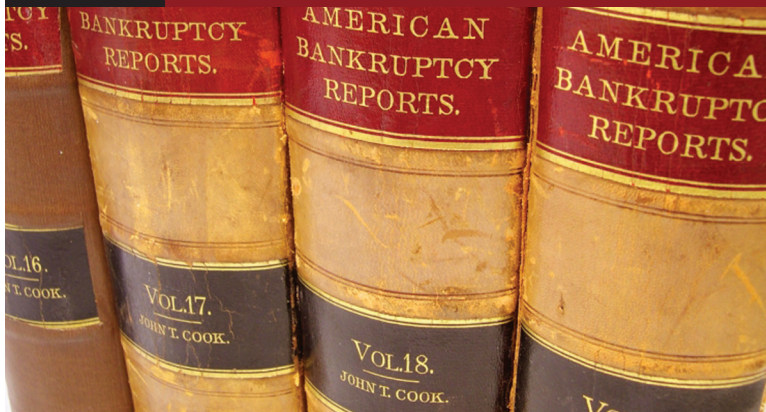


# 30th Annual NW Bankruptcy Institute
