**Stanford Law Professor Pamela S. Karlan** will give the keynote presentation. **Reed College Professor Paul Gronke** will then join Professor Karlan to discuss critical issues in election law. The annual Oregon constitutional law case review will complete the CLE.



**Professor Karlan** is co-director of Stanford's Supreme Court Litigation Clinic, where students litigate live cases before the Court. One of the nation's leading experts on voting and the political process, she has served as a commissioner on the California Fair Political Practices Commission. Professor Karlan is the co-author of leading casebooks on constitutional law, constitutional litigation, and the law of democracy, as well as numerous scholarly articles.



**Professor Gronke** is the Director of the Early Voting Information Center. Professor Gronke served for eight years as editor of the Election Law Journal, an interdisciplinary journal of election law, administration, and politics, and is currently co-editor of PS: Political Science and Politics, one of three flagship journals of the American Political Science Association.
