10 This matter having come before the court on the stipulation
11 of plaintiff and defendant attached hereto, the court having
12 reviewed the pleadings on file herein and having found good cause
13 to have been shown;

14 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECREED as follows:

15 1. Defendant Claudean Ferrel dba Paralegal Plus is hereby
16 permanently and forever enjoined from either directly or through
17 business or subsidiary owned or operated by defendant Claudean
18 Ferrel engaging in the unlawful practice of law in violation of
19 ORS 9.160 or otherwise, including but not limited to any of the
20 following particulars:

21 a. advising individuals and residents of the state of
22 Oregon regarding the need for and benefits and effects of living
23 trusts and related documents as estate planning devices and
24 further advising individuals about avoidance of taxes, probate,
25 conservatorship and guardianship;

26 b. advising individuals regarding forms of living
