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12           The above-entitled matter came before Multnomah County Circuit Court Judge Christopher J.  
13 Marshall for trial on March 13, 2006.

14           Plaintiff, Oregon State Bar, appeared through its attorney, Gregory L. Gudger, Special  
15 Counsel. Defendant Sherrie Holmgren appeared in person, *pro se*. The Court heard opening  
16 statements and testimony, received several exhibits and considered closing arguments by the parties.  
17 Thereafter, the Court made the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in favor of  
18 Plaintiff on March 13, 2006:

- 19   1.       The Oregon State Bar met its burden in proving that Defendant Sherrie Holmgren, dba  
20           "Always Lasting Documents," has engaged in the practice of law without a license by  
21           providing advice and taking actions relative to, and on behalf of, Christine Randel regarding a  
22           bankruptcy, beginning in July 2003, and constituting a violation of ORS 9.160.
- 23   2.       In providing such advice and taking actions relative to and on behalf of Christine Randel,  
24           Sherrie Holmgren, dba "Always Lasting Documents," violated the "Cease and Desist  
25           Agreement" she entered into with the Oregon State Bar on June 23, 2003, violating provisions  
26           1(a), 1(b), 1(c), and 1(e) of said agreement. Violation of the agreement, by its terms,

1 constitutes a violation of ORS 9.160.

2 3. The Bar has met its burden in proving that Defendant Sherrie Holmgren, dba "Always Lasting  
3 Documents," violated ORS 9.160 by providing advice to and selecting documents for Brandon  
4 Williams for his bankruptcy beginning in April 2004.

5 4. The Bar has met its burden in proving that Defendant Sherrie Holmgren, dba "Always Lasting  
6 Documents," violated the June 23, 2003 "Cease and Desist Agreement" entered into with the  
7 Oregon State Bar, in providing advice, selecting documents, and otherwise providing services  
8 to Brandon Williams in contravention of provisions 1(a) 1(b), and 1(c) of said "Cease and  
9 Desist Agreement." Violation of the agreement, by its terms, constitutes a violation of ORS  
10 9.160.

11 5. Christine Randal is entitled to restitution from Defendant Sherrie Holmgren, dba "Always  
12 Lasting Documents," in the amount of two hundred thirty dollars (\$230.00), and Brandon  
13 Williams is entitled to restitution from Defendant Sherrie Holmgren, "Always Lasting  
14 Documents" in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

15 Now, therefore,

16 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant, directly or  
17 indirectly, or through any business, corporation, or subsidiary, or as director, officer, employee, agent  
18 or otherwise, is hereby strictly and permanently enjoined from practicing law, including:

19 6. Enjoined from any personal contact with other persons in the nature of consultation,  
20 explanation, recommendation, or advice regarding the other persons' legal matters;

21 7. Enjoined from meeting with any persons to discuss those persons' individual facts and  
22 circumstances relating to the need or desire for legal forms, legal services or legal assistance;

23 8. Enjoined from obtaining information orally, in writing, or in any other manner, relating to  
24 other persons' individual facts and circumstances so as to assist those persons with their legal  
25 matters;

26 9. Enjoined from advising any persons regarding their eligibility for or the advisability of legal

1 remedies to address those persons' particular legal matters;

2 10. Enjoined from advising any persons regarding procedural functions of the court system as it  
3 relates to those persons' particular legal matters including advice regarding jurisdiction or  
4 venue;

5 11. Enjoined from assisting any persons in selecting particular forms, documents or pleadings to  
6 address those persons' legal matters;

7 12. Enjoined from assisting in any way with the preparation or filling out of legal forms, or any  
8 parts of such forms, documents or pleadings for any other persons;

9 13. Enjoined from assisting, suggesting or advising other persons how forms, documents or  
10 pleadings should be used to address or solve particular legal problems;

11 14. Nothing in this Judgment and Decree precludes Defendant from working for someone  
12 authorized to practice law so long as she is acting within the course of her duties and under the  
13 direction and supervision of an individual authorized to practice law.

14 FURTHER, A MONEY JUDGMENT AND AWARD is rendered as follows:

15 15. Plaintiff is awarded, on behalf of Christine Randel, a money judgment in the amount of Two  
16 Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$230.00);

17 16. Plaintiff is awarded, on behalf of Brandon Williams, a money judgment in the amount of Two  
18 Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), and,

19 17. Plaintiff is awarded judgment against Defendant, for its costs and disbursements and attorneys'  
20 fees incurred herein, in an amount to be determined under ORCP 68.




