6 9.160 et seq, including, but not limited to:

7 (a) Rendering advice to third persons or entities which
8 involves the application of legal principles to individual
9 factual circumstances of such third persons;

10 (b) Selecting, drafting or completing legal documents to be
11 used by third parties in the conduct of such third parties' legal
12 affairs;

13 (c) Representing to any court or tribunal that Defendants
14 are acting on behalf of any third party or entity before such
15 court or tribunal; and

16 (d) Advertising, marketing or holding Defendants out as
17 having particular knowledge or expertise in the conduct and legal
18 affairs of third parties.

19 Violation of this Judgment shall be punishable by contempt
20 in the above captioned court, and shall subject any violating
21 defendant to fine or incarceration pursuant to applicable law.
