This matter came before the undersigned Judge as a stipulation on the record of the parties, and without admission of liability by Defendant. Plaintiff appeared through Amber Hollister, deputy general counsel of the Oregon State Bar, and Marc K. Sellers, special counsel for the bar. Defendant Jerry C. Reeves appeared *pro se*. Based on the stipulation of the parties, good cause being shown:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

Defendant Jerry C. Reeves (Defendant Reeves), directly or indirectly, or through any business, corporation, or subsidiary, or as director, officer, employee, agent or otherwise, shall be and is hereby strictly and permanently enjoined, directly and indirectly, and through any business corporation, entity or subsidiary thereof, whether as officer, director or

1 employee, agent or otherwise, from engaging in activities which constitute the practice of  
2 law subject to ORS 9.160(3) and *Oregon State Bar v. Fowler*, 278 Or 169 (1977) and except  
3 as authorized by ORS 88.010 and 88.020, including:

- 4 A. Any personal contact with any person in the nature of consultation,  
5 explanation, recommendation or advice regarding their legal matters;
- 6 B. Meeting with any persons to discuss their individual facts and  
7 circumstances relating to their need or desire for legal forms, legal  
8 services or legal assistance;
- 9 C. Obtaining information orally, in writing, or in any other manner relating to  
10 individual facts and circumstances so as to assist any persons with their  
11 legal matters;
- 12 D. Advising any persons regarding their eligibility for or the advisability of  
13 pursuing legal remedies to address any person's particular legal matters;
- 14 E. Advising any persons regarding procedural functions of the court system  
15 as it relates to any person's particular legal matters, including advice  
16 regarding judicial and non-judicial foreclosures;
- 17 F. Assisting in selecting particular forms, documents or pleadings for any  
18 persons to address their legal matters;
- 19 G. Assisting, suggesting, or advising any persons on forms, documents or  
20 pleadings which should be used to address or solve particular legal  
21 problems;
- 22 H. Appearing in court to represent the interests of other persons;
- 23 I. Appearing in court to make legal arguments on behalf of other persons;




