8 Based on the stipulation of plaintiff and defendant
9 Earhl Schooff now, therefore, it is hereby

10 ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Schooff be and he hereby is
11 prohibited from engaging in any of the following activites, by
12 himself or through any organization, unless and until he is
13 licensed to practice law in the state of Oregon.

14 1. Advising any person in their particular circumstances
15 regarding the legal effect of any document or documents relating to
16 or affecting the legal rights, duties or remedies of such person,
17 including, without limitation, the necessity or desirability of
18 using a particular form or forms in particular fact situations.

19 2. Advising any person in their particular circumstances
20 regarding the legal effect of establishing an "irrevocable express
21 equity trust," or any similar trust for the receipt of assets, in-
22 cluding, without limitation, the specific effects of such trust on
23 the state or federal tax liability of the parties to such trust

24 or in preparing any legal documents for such trust. Nothing in
25 this stipulation shall prevent Mr.Schooff from outlining the general
26

1 benefits of such trusts.

2 3. Preparing or filing state or federal tax forms in con-
3 junction with any of the activities mentioned above.

4 4. Nothing in this order shall prevent Mr. Schooff from
5 seeking legal advice on behalf of affiliates or fellow trustees from
6 qualified attorneys and conveying such advice to them.

7 5. Nothing in this order shall be construed as denying
8 Mr. Schooff's constitutional and civil rights and particularly
9 his First Amendment rights and this stipulation shall not be
10 construed to be an admission by Mr. Schooff that he has ever been or
11 is presently engaged in the practice of law.

12 6. Nothing in this order shall impinge upon Mr. Schooff
13 rights to act as a trustee or director other than as specifically
14 prohibited in this stipulation.


