BASED UPON the stipulation of the parties appearing below by and through their attorneys of record, and the Court being fully advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

RECITALS

Plaintiff brought this action to enjoin Defendant from

1 the unauthorized practice of law. Defendant contends that he has
2 not engaged in the unauthorized practice of law. Nothing
3 contained herein shall be deemed an admission that Defendant has
4 engaged in the unauthorized practice of law in the past, or a
5 concession by the Plaintiff that he has not.

7 INJUNCTION

8 1. Defendant is hereby permanently enjoined from engaging
9 in the unlawful practice of law, in violation of ORS 9.160 or
10 otherwise.
11

12 2. Defendant may, as a scrivener, prepare forms selected
13 by, and as directed by, his customers, which forms have been
14 approved or may be approved in the future by any judicial unit or
15 entity or any governmental unit or entity, including, without
16 limitation, standard court-mandated bankruptcy forms in Chapter 7
17 cases, initial cover-sheet filings of Chapter 13 cases, and
18 standardized domestic relations documents promulgated by the
19 Oregon Department of Justice, provided that in doing so he does
20 not:

22 A. Exercise professional judgment in applying legal
23 principles to address another person's individualized needs
24 through analysis, advice or other assistance;

25 B. Recommend, select or draft a particular legal form
26 to address another person's particular legal problem or


