If I engage in unethical, illegal or unprofessional conduct as a courtesy seating applicant or examinee, I may be reported to the Client Assistance Office of the Oregon State Bar, the disciplinary authority of any jurisdiction to which I am a member and the admission authority of any jurisdiction to which I have applied or indicated I will apply.
6. This application form is to be used by present members of the Oregon State Bar only. Applicants who are not current members of the Oregon State Bar must use the bar exam application that is applicable to the administration for which I wish to apply.
