I ask for your vote for the Region 8 position on the Board of Governors for the Oregon State Bar.

I am a partner with Miller Nash LLP in its Vancouver, Washington office. I have lived in Vancouver for 23 years and have been a member of the Oregon State Bar for nearly 27 years. I have been a member of the Washington State Bar Association since 1996 and the Idaho State Bar since 2015.

I am very familiar with the issues currently facing the Oregon State Bar and believe I can be a positive force in advocating for OSB members who live and work out-of-state. I have attended and have spoken at meetings of the Oregon State Bar relating to the licensing of paraprofessionals and have closely followed OSB committees, including the Licensure Pathways Development Committee as it explores options beyond a standardized bar examination for law school graduates.

I am past President of the Washington State Bar Association and served on the Washington State Board of Governors for Southwest Washington from 2017 to 2020. During that time, I served on committees examining litigation across the country, including Oregon, weighing the role of integrated bar associations and the constitutional challenges they face. I created and chaired a council that guides the long-range strategic planning for the staff and members of the WSBA. I currently chair a committee dedicated to improving how the WSBA administers boards appointed by the Washington Supreme Court. I have enjoyed working closely with bar association staff, volunteers and the courts.

I am a Fellow with the American Bar Foundation and a state delegate to the ABA House of Delegates. I am a member of the National Conference of Bar Presidents and regularly attend conferences with representatives from across the country who share ideas and programs designed to improve state and local bar associations. I have attended the Western States Bar Conference and the American Bar Association Midyear and Annual Meetings. Locally, I served as past Chair of the Clark County Food Bank and as a board member for the Humane Society for SW Washington for seventeen years. I will bring with me my background of volunteer work with state bar associations if elected to serve as Governor representing Region 8.
