

An attorney shall no longer be eligible to obtain the subsidy if the client ceases the representation, if the client is no longer eligible for the MMP, or if the attorney withdraws from the representation. The OSB may also discontinue the Subsidy.

Subsidy

For eligible FED cases, the Subsidy shall be provided to the attorney on the rate that an attorney bills an eligible MMP client beyond the initial \$35 consultation. The Subsidy shall be as follows:

Rate Billed to Client	Additional Subsidy Provided
\$60 per hour	\$100 per hour
\$80 per hour	\$100 per hour
\$100 per hour	\$100 per hour

The Subsidy is based on actual hours billed to the client for work done. Expenses or other charges incurred are not subject to an additional Subsidy. Attorneys are eligible for a Subsidy of a maximum of \$700.00 per case or matter.

Attorneys with matters eligible for the subsidy will submit a statement of time billed to the OSB RIS monthly for payment. The OSB will review submitted statements and provide the additional subsidy to the attorney within 30 days of submission.

OSB will continue to provide the subsidy for eligible matters until the expiration of grant funds, unless extended by the OSB.

Disputes

If the client files a fee dispute in the matter, the OSB reserves the right to reclaim any subsidy that is successfully challenged by a client.

In the event a client is no longer eligible for the MMP, the OSB reserves the right to reclaim any subsidy provided to the attorney after the finding that the client is not eligible for MMP.
