

## Personal Information of Certain Government Attorneys

Oregon State Bar membership data is subject to the Oregon Public Records Law (ORS 192.311 et seq.) pursuant to ORS 9.010. Therefore, member contact information generally is subject to disclosure upon request.

Certain government employees who are members of the Oregon State Bar may request that the OSB not disclose the member's home address, home or cellular telephone number or personal electronic mail address. See ORS 192.345(32)(a) and ORS 192.345(32)(b). This exemption from public disclosure applies to members who are currently employed as one of the following:

- district attorney, deputy district attorney
- Attorney General or an assistant attorney general
- the United States Attorney for the District of Oregon or an assistant United States attorney for the District of Oregon
- a city attorney who engages in the prosecution of criminal matters or a deputy city attorney who engages in the prosecution of criminal matters.

In order to qualify, the member must complete the form entitled *Request for Exemption of Personal Information of Certain Government Attorneys* and return to the attention of:

- Membership records
- All other records maintained by the OSB
